
Prayers of Petition (4 minutes)

 Definition: Requesting help or guidance. This is the most understood type of prayer and it is a prayer requesting intervention.

Discuss how these prayers express personal needs and desires to the divine.

 Traditions: Prayers of petition, where individuals request help, guidance, or specific needs from a divine source. This form of prayer is a common aspect in various faiths, as it reflects a fundamental human inclination to seek assistance and connection with a higher power or greater reality. Examples include...

- Christianity: In Christianity, the prayer of petition is a heartfelt appeal to God for needs and desires. These prayers express a deep trust in God's benevolence and power, often seeking guidance, provision, and protection. Central to both personal devotion and communal worship.
- Judaism: Jewish prayers often include petitions, especially in the context of daily prayers like the Amidah, which contains several blessings and requests for health, prosperity, and forgiveness.
- Buddhism: While Buddhism does not traditionally involve prayer to a deity for personal requests in the same way as theistic religions, certain practices like Metta (loving-kindness meditation) can include wishes for the well-being of oneself and others, which can be seen as a form of petition.
- Sikhism: In Sikhism, prayers like the Ardas are recited, which include petitions for the welfare of all humanity and requests for guidance and support from the Divine (Waheguru).
- Indigenous and Native Traditions: Many indigenous cultures around the world have prayer practices that include petitions. These prayers often involve requests

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The Metta Meditation is an open ritual from the Buddhist tradition and an inclusive practice.

Objective: To cultivate loving-kindness within the group and extend it outward to the world.

Duration: 15-20 minutes

Instructions:

Introduction to Metta Meditation (3 minutes): Briefly explain the concept of Metta or loving-kindness meditation, emphasizing its roots in Buddhist practice and its focus on cultivating compassion and empathy towards oneself and others.

Forming a Circle (2 minutes): Arrange the participants in a circle, either sitting or standing, to create a sense of unity and connection.

Guided Start (5 minutes): Begin with a guided introduction to Metta meditation. Ask everyone to close their eyes and take a few deep breaths to center themselves. Guide them to silently repeat phrases of loving-kindness towards themselves, such as "May I be happy, may I be healthy, may I be safe, may I live with ease."

Passing the Metta (5-10 minutes):

Start the passing of Metta: one participant turns to the person on their left and, maintaining eye contact, says the Metta phrases, personalizing it for the other person, e.g., "May you be happy, may you be healthy, may you be safe, may you live with ease." The recipient then internalizes this Metta by repeating the phrases to themselves silently, embracing the loving-kindness they've received. This recipient then turns to their left and repeats the process, offering Metta to the next person in the circle.

Extending Metta Outward (3 minutes): Once the Metta has circulated back to the starting person, lead the group in extending these intentions outwards. Together, the group says, "May we be happy, may we be healthy, may we be safe, may we live with ease." Finally, expand the loving-kindness to the world: "May all beings be happy, may all beings be healthy, may all beings be safe, may all beings live with ease."

Closing Reflection (2 minutes):

Invite the group to reflect on the experience of both giving and receiving Metta. Encourage a few moments of silent reflection on the power of loving-kindness and its rippling effect in the world.



Possible Activity: Passing the Metta



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Poly-Faith

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(Begin by inviting everyone to find a comfortable seated position. Encourage them to gently close their eyes if they feel at ease doing so.)

"Let's take a moment to center ourselves as we come to the close of our gathering. Breathe deeply, inhaling peace and acceptance, exhaling any tension or reservations. With each breath, feel more present in this space, more grounded in this moment.

(Allow a few moments for deep breathing.)

Now, visualize a warm, embracing light surrounding you. This light represents unconditional love and acceptance. It radiates compassion, understanding, and a deep sense of peace. Feel this light as it gently envelops you, affirming your identity, your journey, and your truth.

(Pause for reflection.)

In this space of love and light, let us affirm together: 'I am an expression of Divine Love. My queer identity is a beautiful aspect of my unique self, deserving of respect and celebration."
